SWEEPSTAKES

The Alamo Area Shetland Sheepdog Club Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all breeders and owners of Shetland Sheepdogs. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the regular classes. Entry fee shall be \$8.00 for each puppy/junior and entries shall be made in the space marked "Additional Classes" on the premium list by writing "Sweepstakes" and "6-9, 9-12, or 12-18". All entries in the Puppy Sweepstakes must also be entered in a regular class at the regular fee.

Distribution of Sweepstakes Prize Money: 35% of the total entry fee for the sweepstakes shall be reserved for expenses. 10% of the remaining entry fee shall be awarded to Best in Sweepstakes. The balance shall be divided as follows according to the number of entries in each individual class:

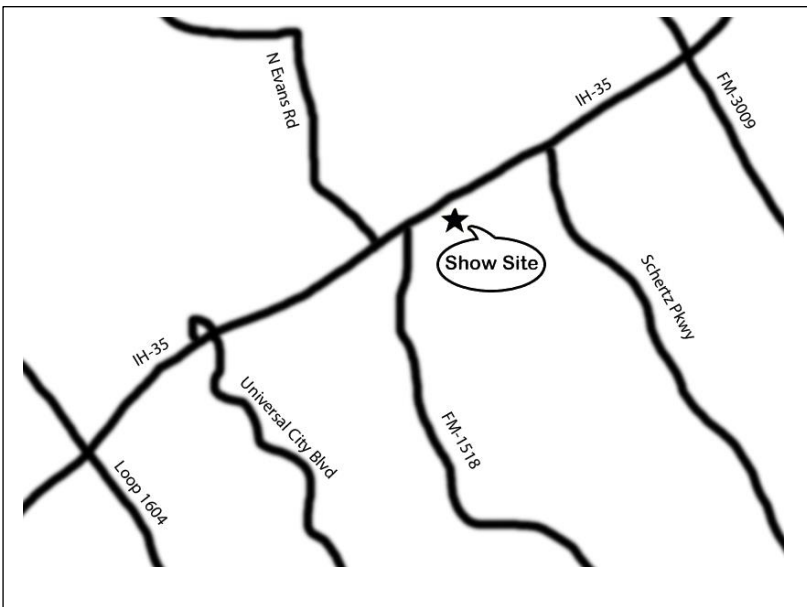

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

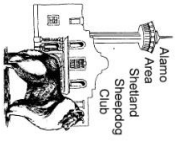
